APRIL 3: USING REINFORCEMENT TO INCREASE SKILLS AND DECREASE CHALLENGING BEHAVIORS

Learn about the different types of reinforcement used in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) to increase needed skills and to decrease unwanted behaviors. Practical examples of reinforcement strategies that can be utilized in the home will be taught. Templates will be provided for common reinforcement systems to easily used.

APRIL 10: ADDRESSING COMMON COMMUNICATION ISSUES

This training will address different types of receptive and expressive communication issues that are presented in ASD. Treatment strategies will be discussed along with available resources in this domain. In addition, the importance of communication between different treatment providers will be examined with strategies to better improve for your child's treatment.

APRIL 24: USING VISUAL SUPPORTS

This training will focus on the use of visual supports that can be utilized in the home and the community for individuals with ASD. Visual supports can be used to assist in scheduling, teaching new skills, and reducing problem behaviors. Resources will be shared for parents to easily create and use for their child.
